		Senior Camper has chosen to participate in this program, and by doing so has been given a reduced camp fee. This reduced fee does require camper to participate in a minimum of 72 program hours during the regular camp day (8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.), along with adhering to the program requirements listed in this contract.
		Senior Camper agrees to attend at least two in-camp days (Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday) of Week One (June 20th-24th). If he/she is unable to do so, you will need to contact Parks and Recreation to apply for an exemption from this requirement.
		Senior Camper is expected to be courteous, friendly, and respectful to all other campers/senior campers, recognizing that this is a key component to being a strong leader and team member.
		Senior Camper is expected to deal with problems with other campers in a safe, calm manner and will make every effort to resolve issues in a mature and respectful way.
		Senior Camper understands that social cruelty (bullying, teasing, sarcasm and criticism or words that are intended to be a "put down") will not be tolerated.
		Senior Camper understands that there is a zero-tolerance policy for any type of physical violence (hitting, fighting, restraining, etc.).
		Senior Camper agrees to be involved in the planning and implementation of either one special event for the younger campers during the course of the summer, and/or at least one community service project. Camper will have the opportunity to provide input regarding what type(s) of special events and/or community service projects will be accomplished.
		Senior Camper understands that any disciplinary action taken regarding violation of any camp rules may result in loss of senior camper status ; Camp discount will no longer apply and parent will be required to pay a prorated fee in order to keep camper in camp for remainder of summer.
