Adventure Campers are expected to be courteous, friendly, and respectful to all other campers and staff, recognizing that this is a key component to being a strong leader.
		Adventure Campers are expected to deal with problems with other campers in a safe, calm manner and will make every effort to resolve issues in a mature and respectful way.
		Adventure Campers understand that social cruelty (bullying, teasing, sarcasm and criticism or words that are intended to be a "put down") will not be tolerated. Adventure Campers understand that there is a zero-tolerance policy for any type of physical violence (hitting, fighting, restraining, etc.).
		Adventure Campers are expected to follow all bus rules while on field trips. Campers may use cell phones on designated long bus rides, but if any problems arise, phone will be taken and given back to a parent/guardian at the end of the camp day.
		Adventure Campers agree to be involved in fundraising opportunities to raise money for the overnight trip at the end of the summer.
		Adventure Campers agree to be involved in the planning and implementation of games and activities for the younger campers on scheduled days.
		Adventure Campers understand that any disciplinary action taken regarding violation of any camp rules may result in the following;
