

Lowell Preserve - 308-acre wooded preserve located at 47 Falmouth Road in East Windham.

Mountain Division Trail - Paved rail with trail for biking and walking that connects Windham, Gorham, & Standish. Parking available off Gambo Road.

Windham Community Park - Located next to the Windham Public Safety building, 373 Gray Rd in Windham. The park includes a skate park, basketball courts, volleyball courts and a picnic pavilion!

East Windham Conservation Area -

The newest destination in Windham, 100 acre preserve is located at 189 Falmouth Road in East Windham.

Black Brook Preserve - 105-acre preserve on Windham Center Road, owned by the Presumpscot Regional Land Trust, parking on Windham Center Rd.
